Fee Charge for Receiving Paper Pension Check; No Charge if Direct Deposit is Used

The Trustees of the St. Paul Electrical Workers Pension Plan recently set the charge for participants who elect to receive their pension benefit with a paper check, as opposed to obtaining their pension benefit through direct deposit.

IF YOU ARE RECEIVING A PENSION BENEFIT:

- There is no charge if you receive your pension benefit by direct deposit.
- If you receive your pension benefit by a paper check, your account will be charged \$35 per pension check.

These rules take effect on January 1, 2019.
